So, when Norma was severely ill at 89, the doctors decided that it would no longer be safe for her to live on her own. Without hesitating, Chris proposed to take care of her in his apartment. Norma was thrilled by the offer. Chris cooked for her, and the two spent time together watching the news, talking and sharing meals.

❸ A few months later, Norma died, and Chris was heartbroken. However, their relationship has stuck with him for so long. The love and care they shared is a truly shining example that just a little kindness really goes a long way. "I feel her watching over me and it is a happy feeling. I am forever a changed man and I thank this magnificent lady for everything she has taught me," he said.
