THE TEXT

1. Bethany Hamilton has no regrets. She tells the audience: "I lost my arm but I wouldn't change it." Seventeen years ago, a shark took the left arm of **the surfing prodigy** at age 13, and people have wanted to know her story ever since. Her resilience and successful return to competitive surfing, just a few months later, have made her an idol to many. She has been on every chat show and in every teenage magazine.

2. Unusually in a professional athlete as driven as Hamilton, she agrees she has had more impact as a survivor rather than as one of Hawaii's best surfers. "I didn't set out my life to have a great impact or anything. But it is really beautiful to see all the good that's come from what seems like such an awful thing," she says. Hamilton's openness about everyday struggles forms another part of her burgeoning career as a life coach and motivational figure, particularly to teenage girls.

3. One of those good things is the new portrayal of her life. The plan was to make a 10-minute action film to promote women's surfing. Seven years later, the result is *Unstoppable*, a 100-minute documentary. "I think it turned out amazing and really captures my whole life thus far in a way that any other portrayals of my story haven't ... plus **it's** the real me," she says. Hamilton has lived more than half her life in the public eye and encountered fame at an early age, all stemming from a single incident; yet she refuses to let it define her.

It is trash season on Bali, when storms wash up tons of plastic debris onto the island's beaches. It is the time for two teenage sisters, Melati and Isabel Wijsen, to organize their annual island ① Megaphones in hand, they kick off a day of trash ② at 115 sites around the island. Thousands of people come out to help.
